Volunteers Needed for Stream Clean-up June 15

LAKE GEORGE, NY – (JUNE 8, 2010)

The Lake George Association (LGA) is seeking volunteers for the first of two lake-saving clean-up projects this summer.

Volunteers should meet at the corner of West Brook Road and Beach Road in Lake George at 10 am on Tuesday, June 15. The clean-up will last approximately two hours.

Alongside LGA educators Kristen Rohne and Jill Trunko, volunteers will provide a needed community service to protect Lake George. After cleaning up West Brook, volunteers will learn about stream monitoring and sampling for macro invertebrates, if they are interested. The LGA will provide wading boots and garbage bags; volunteers are encouraged to dress for the weather and to wear hats and sunscreen (and their own water shoes or boots if available).
