

New Fertilizer Regulations for Town and Village of Lake George

All fertilizers applied to lawns must be phosphorus free.

The new regulations do not apply to flowers and vegetables, and trees and shrubs.



Look For the Zero.

The three numbers on fertilizer bags show the nitrogen-phosphorus-potassium (N-P-K) nutrient analysis. The middle number is the phosphate (phosphorus) content. A 'zero' in the middle means it is phosphorus-free. Most established northeastern lawns only need nitrogen to stay healthy.
