**Due to the increasing requests for Floating Classroom programs, the Lake George Association has adopted the following policy for booking school programs that aligns with the values and educational goals of the Lake George Association: to develop and deliver educational materials and programs aimed at informing students and residents about what actions they can take to keep Lake George water clean and healthy.**

- Schools within the Lake George watershed will be given first priority in booking dates for fall and spring programs. These include schools located in Lake George, Bolton, Lake Luzerne, Warrensburg, Ticonderoga, Putnam, Fort Ann, Whitehall, and Queensbury. Fall priority booking will be from May-August and Spring priority booking will be from November-February. Teachers will be contacted via e-mail when priority booking opens.
  - Limited to one full grade per district. (If grade size is small, multiple grades can come to fill a single day.)
  - Schools will be given 1 day for 1-60 students, 2 days for 60-120 students, 3 days for 120-180 students etc.
- For schools outside of the Lake George watershed, fall booking will begin in August, and spring booking will begin in February. Booking may be opened up sooner if all in-watershed schools have been booked. Please contact us in May-August to be put on a waiting list for Fall programs or in November-February to be put on a waiting list for Spring programs.
  - Schools able to come for the full 4 and a half hour program will be given first priority.

We care deeply about teaching as many students as possible about the importance of keeping Lake George clean. We try to provide Floating Classroom programs for all interested schools; however, days are very limited due to the short length of the school program season, and the length of the school year. We ask that you please be understanding if you are not able to book, and we will continue to do our very best to accommodate as many schools that we can each year.
